

Travel Tips for RemaxWorld Expo 2025

ATTENTION:

The CKS ferry from Hong Kong Airport to Zhuhai is not available any more.

The routing & sailing schedule of the Shenzhen Airport Ferry Terminal to Zhuhai Jiuzhou Port has suspended.

Please select another transportation method if you are travelling to Zhuhai through these airports.

**Reminder: please prepare local currency and change when arriving in different cities to avoid frustration.*

All passengers should prepare local currencies in advance:

- Guangzhou: please prepare Chinese Yuan (RMB);
- Hong Kong: please prepare Hong Kong dollars (HKD);
- Macao: please prepare Macao patacas (MOP).

Please note that official currencies are used in each respective region, and it is recommended to have local currency on hand for your convenience when travelling and during your stay.

	Operating time: 6:00 - 01:20
	Ticket price: MOP6 per person

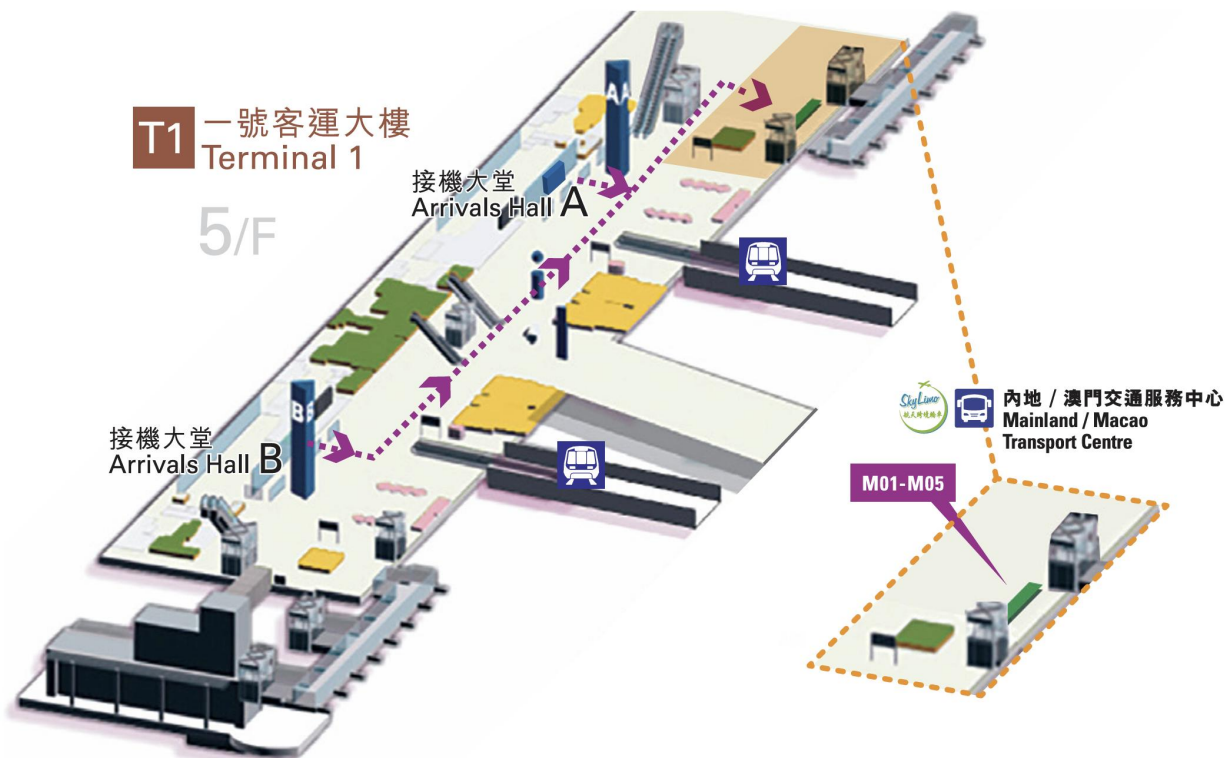

HK International Airport One-stop VIP Share Van

(Recommended)

**Scheduled services take passengers directly to Zhuhai Port every day. Please make sure your travel documents are valid for entering the Mainland.*

Ticketing: Arriving at Terminal 1, HKIA → Purchasing tickets at Counter M01-M05 (different service providers), Mainland/Macao Transport Centre, Hall A of Arrivals Level → The counter staff will take you to board the car



Operating time: 06:40 - 23:00 (Might vary with different service providers)
Frequency: Every 7 - 60 minutes
Trevelling time: About 50 minutes

Ticket prices: HKD200.00 (USD28) per person (Might vary with different service providers)



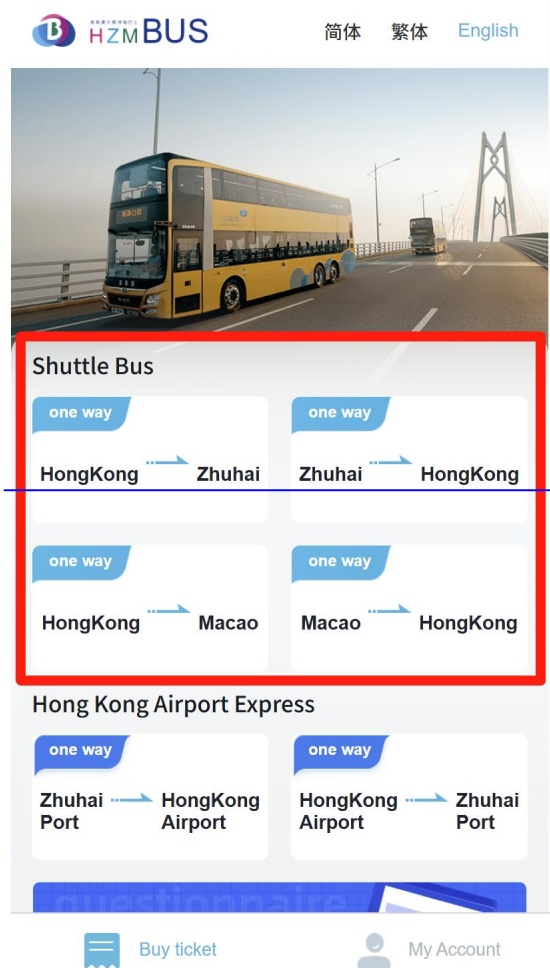
**Clear Immigration and Customs first and collect your luggage. You will need to take two shuttle buses to reach Zhuhai.*

Route: Take bus No. B4 from HKIA Passenger Terminal Building to HZMB Hong Kong Port Passenger Clearance Building → Go through immigration (leaving Hong Kong) → Take the Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macau Bridge Shuttle Bus to Zhuhai Port → Go through Mainland China immigration and customs



Getting to Zhuhai: What are the best options?

For international visitors, Hong Kong International Airport is often the most convenient transit hub for traveling to Zhuhai. To help ensure a smooth journey, here are some useful tips:






After landing in Hong Kong, you now have a faster and more affordable option, the Hong Kong–Zhuhai–Macau Bridge.









If you choose this route, you'll have three ways to continue your trip:

- HK International Airport One-stop VIP Share Van, the most recommended choice for comfort and efficiency.
- HK Airport Express, an alternative option.
- Public shuttle buses, available but not recommended.

Pre-Travel Tips:	Prepare some cash	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. If you are travelling through Hong Kong, have some small currency HK dollars with you. 2. For example, you will need HK\$10 to catch the B4 bus from Hong Kong Airport to the Hong Kong-Macau-Zhuhai-Bridge Border, and no change is given. Credit cards are not accepted either. 3. There is a TRAVELEX booth in the Arrivals area of HK Airport (see photo) that can exchange US dollars, Euros and Chinese RMB on the spot. 4. Arriving in mainland China with some RMB is also helpful, especially if you do not have cash in the WeChat App wallet. 200RMB (about US\$30) will be sufficient for taxis etc. 5. Apart from your hotel, you will most likely not be able to use credit cards for buses and taxis. 		
	Prepare the name and address of your hotel in Chinese	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Ask your hotel to send the name and address to you in Chinese. 2. Show this hard copy or digital copy (on your phone) to your taxi driver to help avoid confusion and get you to the right place. 		
	Download WeChat onto your mobile device	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Have it operational before you leave home; 2. WeChat is an effective tool to engage with your suppliers even after you return home: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. it can translate signs and text into your own language; b. it has a wallet to store money for easy transactions in supermarkets, taxis, street vendors etc. 	Wechat for iOS: 	Wechat for Android:

It is situated at the far-left end of the hall as you leave customs and immigration (see photos). Clearly request Zhuhai. You can use your credit card to purchase a VIP seat all the way to the Zhuhai border over the new Hong Kong – Macau-Zhuhai Bridge (HMZB).  	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Take the elevator down to the street level. Look for and wait at the B4 Bus station (pictured). Pay HKD9 into the collection box next to the driver. Make sure you and your luggage are secure as the bus twists and turns regularly on the road. The trip takes about 10-15 minutes 

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Claim your luggage on the 4th floor of the Sea-Sky Transit Building. 	 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> You will wear an identifying sticker and together with your luggage, you will be escorted to the vehicle in the neighboring car park. <p>You will travel in a comfortable, air-conditioned 8-seater ride-share van.</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The bus will take you to the Hong Kong-Macau-Zhuhai Bridge (HMZB) Immigration (departure) terminal.

Purchase tickets for the HMZB bus. Follow the signs to catch this public bus to the Zhuhai border. 
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Enjoy your trip to Zhuhai over the new Hong Kong - Macau -Zhuhai Bridge (HMZB). You will travel for 35 minutes across the bridge until you reach the Zhuhai, China border where you will enter Mainland China customs and immigration. 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You will travel for 50 minutes across the bridge until you reach the China border where you will enter Mainland China customs and immigration.

When you arrive at the Zhuhai (China Mainland) border you will need to:

- fill in the arrival card, show your passport and visa, and get photographed and fingerprinted.
- put all your luggage through the X-ray scanner to clear customs.
- exit to the taxi area, show the driver your hotel name and address details (see above).

IMPORTANT NOTE

Please abide by the Exit and Entry Administration Law of the People's Republic of China and other laws and regulations, and read the following information carefully.
1. For foreigners who reside or stay in dwellings other than hotels, they or the persons who accommodate them shall, within 24 hours after the foreigners' arrival at the accommodation, go through the registration formalities with the public security organs in the places of residence.
2. Foreigners holding Visa L, H1, D1 or D2 shall apply for residence permits within 30 days after entry with the exit and entry administration authority of the public security organ in the place of residence.
3. Foreigners who work in China shall obtain work permits and work-residence permits.
4. Foreigners having reached the age of 16 who stay or reside in China shall carry with them passports or other international travel documents, or foreigners' stay or residence permits, and accept the inspection of public security organs.
5. Foreigners in China shall leave the country prior to the expiry of the unexpired duration of stay or residence. If they need to continue to stay or reside in China after the expiration, they shall apply for an extension of the duration of stay or residence.
6. Foreign Permanent Resident (C) Card can be used alone as identity document within Chinese mainland.
7. Foreigners violating exit-entry administration laws and regulations may be detained, ordered to exit the country within a time limit, repatriated or denied entry into China etc.
