Art had a close association with RT media and enjoyed an extended career thanks to this relationship

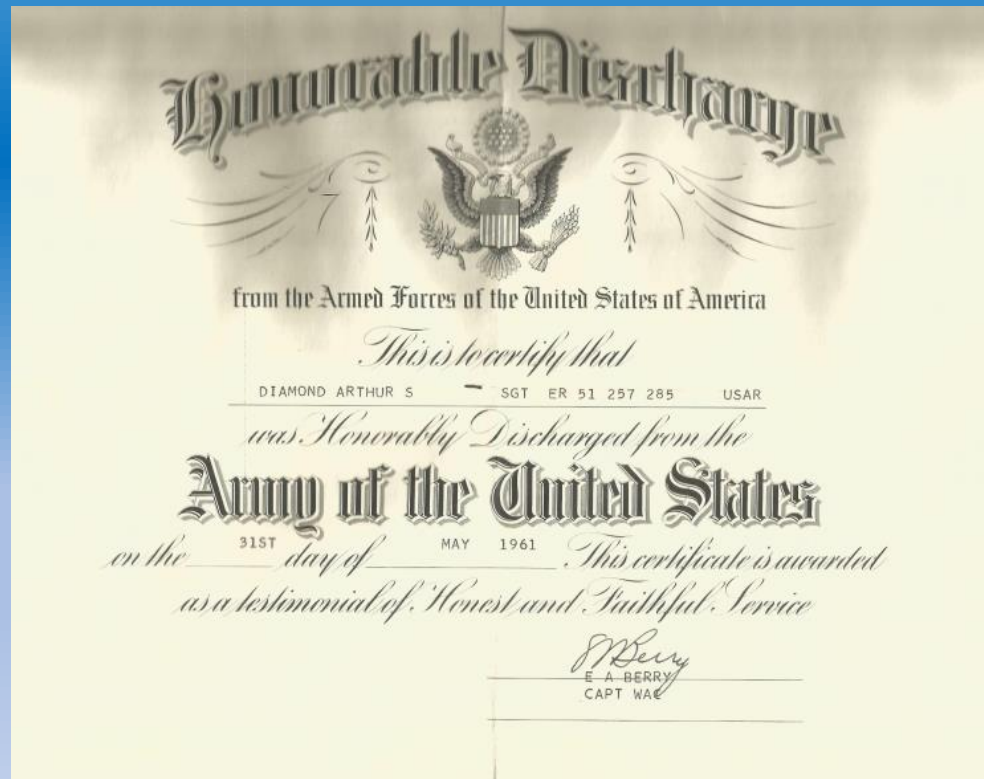
Even at the age of 80 Art was still traveling internationally and giving talks at events such as World Expo

Art became a Registered Professional Engineer in the State of Illinois in 1964

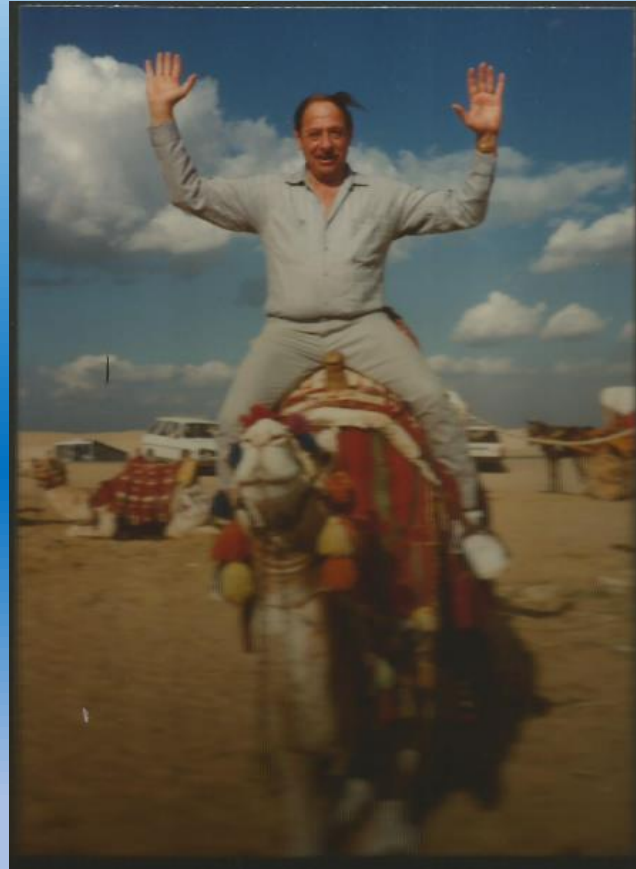


Art founded Diamond Research Corporation in 1969, starting a journey that would last the next 47 years.

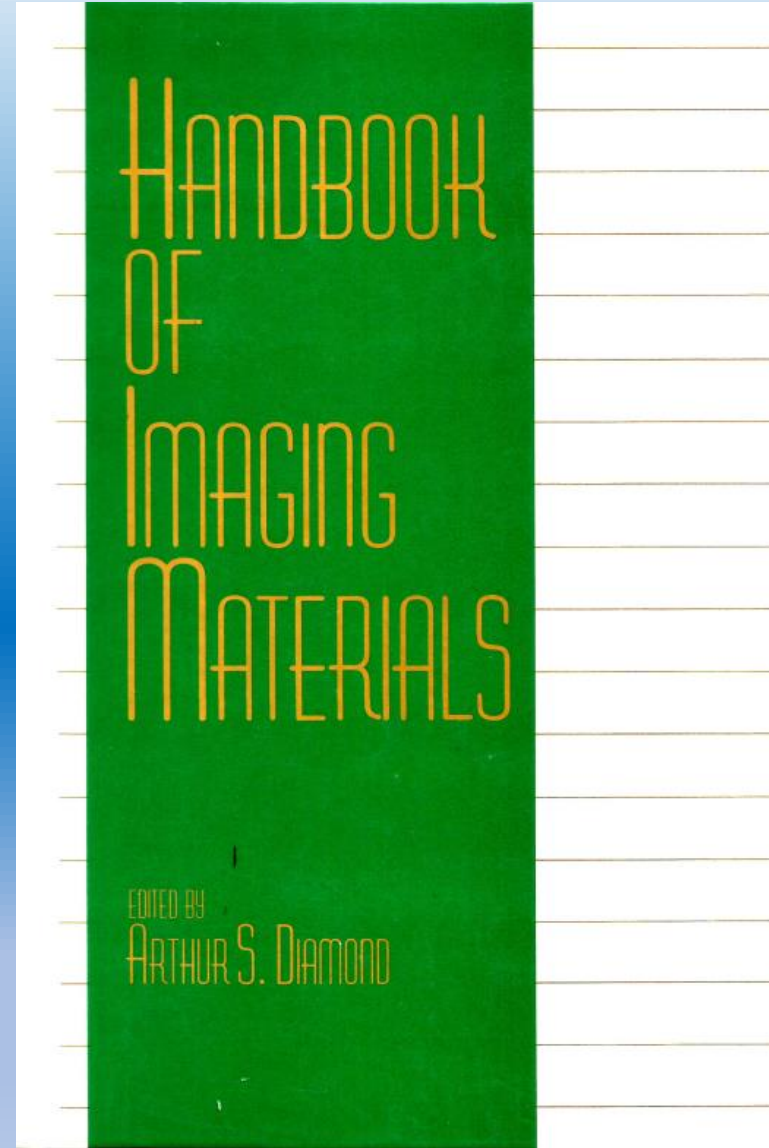

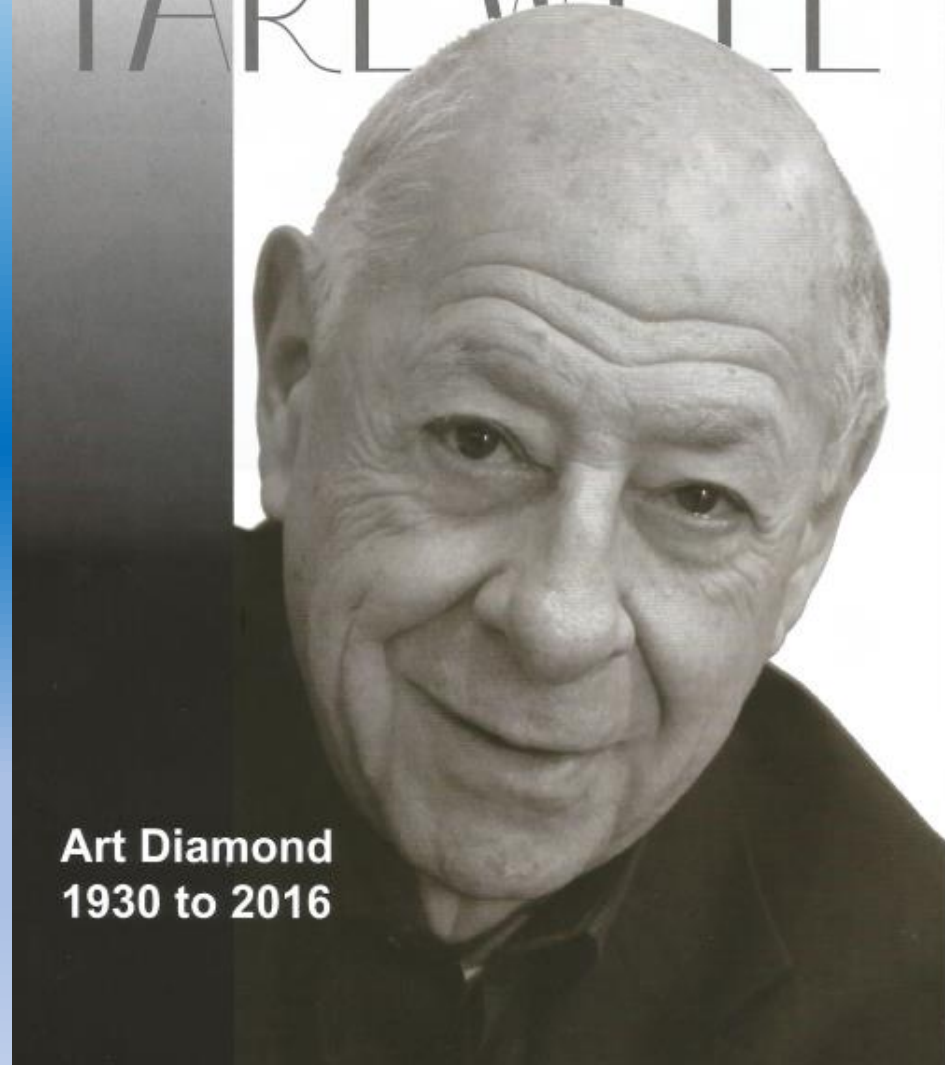
