

Visitors from these countries holding valid international travel documents and tickets with confirmed dates and seats for trip via mainland China <b>to third countries or regions (HongKong included)</b> within 144 hours can apply for visa-free transits at the exit-entry border inspection authorities of the ports in the arriving cities.  2. <b>Visitors can stay for a maximum of 144 hours within Guangdong Province (Zhuhai included).</b> The duration of stay for each foreign national starts from 0:00 on the day following the day of entry.	Guangzhou, Guangdong	Guangzhou Baiyun International Airport Nansha Port (for passenger transport)	Can make cross-province travels within the allowed areas for visa-free transit travelers in these <b>24 provinces</b>	1. Visitors meeting the policy's requirements can enter China through the airports in Guangzhou, Shenzhen and Jieyang, as well as Nansha Port and Shekou Port, and stay for a maximum of 240 hours <b>within the allowed areas for visa-free transit travelers in these 24 provinces.</b>  2. Visitors having entered China through the aforementioned ports in Guangdong Province are permitted to leave China through all the exit-entry ports providing passenger transport services within the province.	<b>We do not recommend visitors to RemaxWorld Expo use this method of entry. It is very complicated. For visitors still wishing to apply for this temporary entry, please note:</b> 1. Make sure your country is on the list the country list. 2. Purchase a one way air ticket to Guangzhou Baiyun International Airport or Shenzhen Bao'an International Airport (see note below). 3.
